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The Fiscal Court in and for Todd County met in regular session at the Courthouse at 9:08 a.m. and the following proceedings were had: The following Magistrates were present:

Alfred Blake, Rex Johnson, John Camp, Brent Spurlin and Jimmy Turner

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The Court opened with the pledge of allegiance, followed by a prayer by Squire Spurlin.

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- Gary Cumbee, Linda Oliver, Terry Stokes, David Stokes and Bill Addison addressed the Court in support of ex-sheriff, Billy Stokes, asking the Court to forgive the money owed by Mr. Stokes.
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- Upon motion of Squire Spurlin, seconded by Squire Blake, it is hereby ordered to approve the July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011 Fiscal Court minutes and file.

Passed on a voice vote

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- Accounts Payable was presented to the Court for review and it is hereby ordered to file and pay all bills subject to state audit.
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- Upon motion of Squire Spurlin, seconded by Squire Turner, it is hereby ordered to approve the July Financial Report subject to state audit.

Passed on a voice vote

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- Upon motion of Squire Turner, seconded by Squire Camp, it is hereby ordered to approve Ordinance 11-06, Reapportionment, with the wording in District #3 to read "...west end of Philippi Rd...", on 2<sup>nd</sup> reading.

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- Interim EMS Director, Locky Beasley, reported that every day is running smoother than the day before.

- Upon motion of Squire Spurlin, seconded by Squire Turner, it is hereby ordered to approve hiring Scott Talbot, Curtis Hoel and Robert Vick as part-time EMT's at \$8.25/hour.

- Upon motion of Squire Blake, seconded by Squire Johnson, it is hereby ordered to approve hiring Jesse Dale and Joe Beasley as part-time Paramedics at \$12.06/hour.

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- Judge Greenfield noted that the FEMA Grant for the radio tower is moving forward.
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- Upon motion of Squire Spurlin, seconded by Squire Johnson, it is hereby ordered to approve hiring Tim Pulley as EMA Director now that his 90 day probationary period has ended.

Passed on a voice vote

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- Upon motion of Squire Blake, seconded by Squire Turner, it is hereby ordered to approve hiring Steven Francis, full-time, as the solid was driver and general laborer.

Passed on a voice vote

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- County Attorney, Mac Johns, noted that the Delinquent Tax sale will be held next Friday. He added that the payment plans have been working well and there will only be a few remaining to be sold.
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- A written Jail report was presented to the Court noting that they are housing an average of 74 inmates per day. The report also notes that staffing has been reduced by 3 full time positions.
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- A written Sheriff Report was presented to the Court.
- Todd County Sheriff, Joey Johnson, reported that they are currently ordering radios for the new system.
- Upon motion of Squire Turner, seconded by Squire Spurlin, it is hereby ordered to approve declaring the Sheriff Department's 2003 Ford Crown Victoria as surplus.

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- Sheriff Johnson asked the Court to consider a noise ordinance for the County.
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- Upon motion of Squire Blake, seconded by Squire Johnson, it is hereby ordered to adjourn.
